



RALLY REGULATIONS



Article 1: Cars allowed to participate

Cars of the MG brand or other.

Article 2 : Procedure

It is a tourist rally on open roads, without any ranking or regularity test.

It is in no case a test of speed or sport.

In the event of a problem with hotel accommodation, only the person responsible for the event has the authority to choose another accommodation.

Article 3 : The Highway Code

Participants undertake to comply with the requirements of the highway code and the municipal laws along the route.

Any possible offences under the highway code, as well as fines thereto, are solely at the charge of the participants.

During visits to a cave, the tasting is taken at the entire responsibility of the driver of the car, in no case can the MGCF be held responsible in the event of a positive alcohol test.

Article 4: Administrative Controls

Drivers certify on honour to be in possession of and able to present the following documents:

- Valid driving licence. This also applies for the passenger in the event that they drive.
- Vehicle Registration Document valid for the car entered.
- Insurance certificate valid for the car entered.
- MOT certificate valid, where applicable.

Article 5 : Technical Verifications

Security control points: tyres, brakes, lights, wipers, security triangle, yellow high-vis jacket, presence of a fire extinguisher is desirable.

The organisers can refuse the departure of a car that shows any safety defects, for which it is not possible to claim compensation.

The rally plates must in no case hide the licence plates and must be firmly fixed to the car.

Article 6: Insurance

Events for which the organisation is done under the guise of the MG Club de France are insured by the Club Policy RC.

Each participant, in the event of an accident, is liable vis-à-vis other participants and third parties and waives any claim for liability from the MG Club of France in any capacity whatsoever.

Article 7: Engagement

A participant who is correctly registered, who does not start, cannot be reimbursed the full amount paid, a sum will be retained by the MG Club de France to cover costs already incurred at the time of the withdrawal, according to the terms of the conditions of cancellation.

Article 8: Application of Regulations

Because of their participation, each participant is considered to have agreed with these regulations and agrees to comply with the decisions of the organisers. In no event shall the MG Club of France be liable in case of accident or offence during the event.
